Classification is a formal procedure that requires a specially trained Physical Therapist to evaluate your muscle, joint, or sensation on a 0-5 scale depending on your disability. Each competitor's strength, mobility, and coordination are also assessed putting them in a classification profile. Once the evaluation is finished the evaluator will file the necessary paperwork and a PE ID Card will be issued. This card will carry a list of the driver's dispensations on the back so that it may also be used if needed at various events.
